
JCWO published its latest work "Toxicity evaluation of ConvitVax breast cancer immunotherapy" in Scientific Reports.

Molecular Diagnostics

The number of beneficiaries continue to grow. As of today, **757** highly vulnerable patients have benefited from this program in Latin America. A new project is under development to expand to other low-income countries of the region.
