Develops ConvitVax, a low cost, simple, personalized, potentially safe and effective breast cancer immunotherapy, targeted to underprivileged patients with the disease.

## 2 Molecular Diagnostics

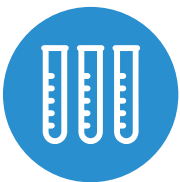


Conceptual design of a vaccine manufacturing plant
