Cancer Immunotherapy



Patent protection for ConvitVax progressed in Brazil, receiving the first office action, while it remains under intellectual property proceedings in the European Union. To date, ConvitVax is legally protected in the United States and Colombia.



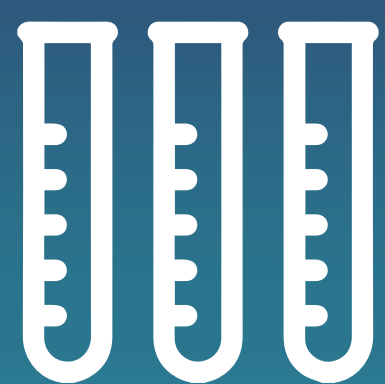
Construction of a vaccine manufacturing facility began this year, marking a significant step toward initiating the first clinical trial with ConvitVax and expanding our operational and scientific capabilities.



Two new scientific articles on ConvitVax and related immunotherapy research were submitted and are currently under peer review in indexed scientific journals, reflecting our ongoing commitment to rigorous investigation and global scientific dissemination.

Molecular Diagnostics



Performed 2,370 tests this year, benefiting 474 highly vulnerable patients and 1,897 relatives, bringing the total number of beneficiaries to 11,790 since the beginning of the program.



Subscribed a new agreement reaching a total of 14 public health institutions impacted by this program in Venezuela, improving timely cancer diagnostics and broader access to molecular testing nationwide.



Extended program coverage to one additional state, strengthening its presence in Venezuela and expanding its reach to 10 of the country's 23 states.

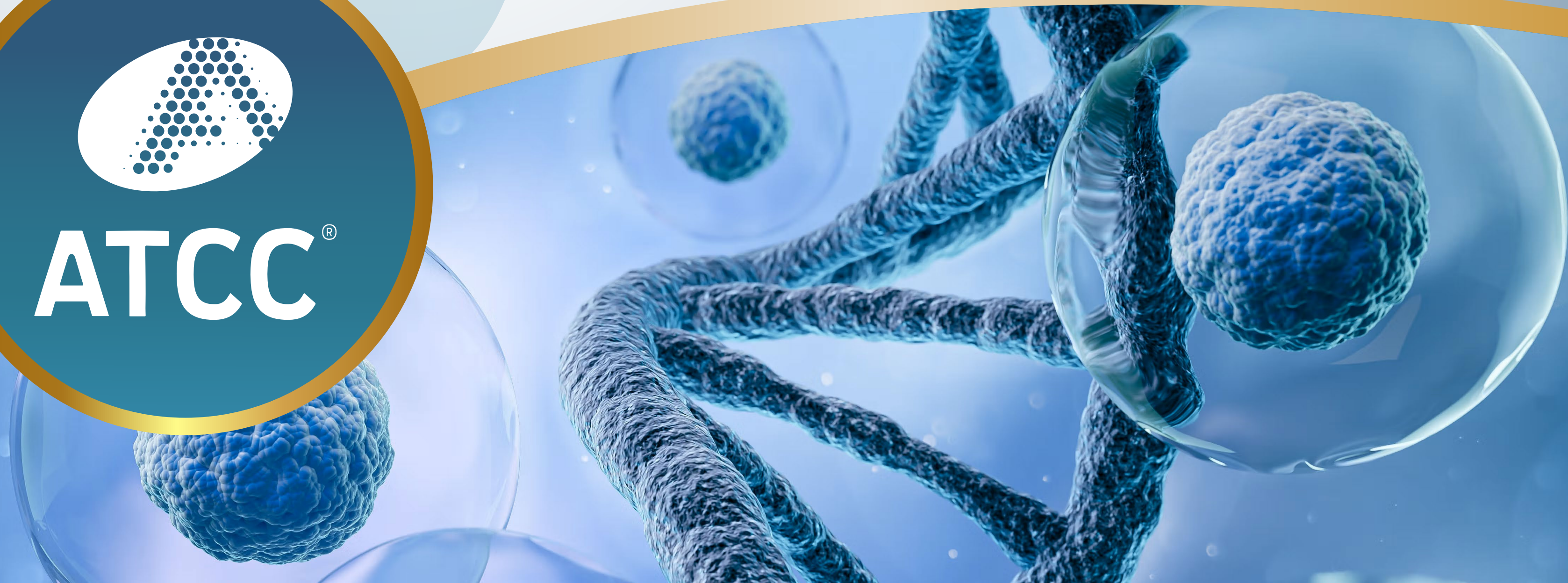
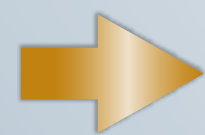


New donation

The American Type Culture Collection (ATCC), a leading American institution in biological materials and standards, formalized an agreement with us, providing seven cell lines to support the work conducted by our Molecular Diagnostics Program (MDP) in partnership with our sister organization in Venezuela.

These cell lines will be used to validate protocols within the MDP, which provides free cancer detection services to individuals living in poverty and extreme poverty. This contribution is a key step in strengthening our capacity to deliver accurate, early diagnoses of malignant neoplastic diseases, improving patient outcomes in vulnerable communities. The collaboration also opens opportunities for future projects, enhancing research capabilities and advancing shared goals in global health and scientific development.

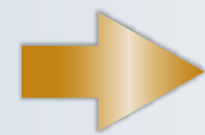
